Hometown: Decatur GA



Cael Chatham - Infielder

Highlights:

A Third Baseman, SS, and Relief Pitcher, Cael was traded to the Washington Wild Things, from the Great Falls Voyagers in Great Falls, Montana in May 2025. The Wild Things are part of a professional baseball league in North America composed of 15 teams in the United States and 3 in Canada. The league is an official MLB Partner League since 2020, and the level of play is comparable to Minor League Baseball's Single-A level. Chatham was drafted by the Voyagers of the Pioneer League in 2024 and became the third signee to sign a professional contract that year.

The Woodstock, Georgia native -- who attended River Ridge High School-- transferred from LaGrange College to become the every day third basemen in the High Point Panthers lineup after four years at LaGrange. A two-year starter in the Purple & White, Chatham was a vacuum at third base as well as a real power threat at the plate.

HPU Head Coach shared that Cael was one of the purest hitters this program has seen and his path from a Division III powerhouse (LaGrange) to help lead HPU to its first ever Big South Championship and NCAA Regional berth.

Hometown: Atlanta, GA


Drafted/Signed: New York Yankees in 2024

Parks played 3 years at UGA, then finished out his lone season as a UNC Tarheel -- leading the team in hitting. He was drafted by the New York Yankees, July 2024, and assigned to the single -A Tampa Tarpons for the end of the season. Parks was traded to the Giants on July 31, 2025.

Cooper McMurray - First Baseman

Cooper McMurray is a professional baseball player in the Atlanta Braves organization. A standout at Auburn University, he hit .326 with a .431 on-base percentage and .588 slugging mark in 61 games during his final college season, finishing his Auburn career with 42 home runs. McMurray began his professional career in 2025 with the Rome Emperors (Braves Single-A affiliate) after signing as an undrafted free agent. Prior to college, he attended Tattnall Square Academy in Georgia, where he excelled as a prep athlete.

Brennan Milone — Pitcher

Brennan Malone is a right-handed pitcher originally from North Carolina and a product of IMG Academy (Bradenton, FL), where he was a highly ranked prep arm. Drafted as a first-round pick by the Arizona Diamondbacks, Malone spent time in the Pittsburgh Pirates system, including with the Bradenton Marauders in 2025, posting a 1–0 record and a 4.45 ERA with 26 strikeouts in 25 appearances. After electing free agency in November 2025, Malone brings experience from multiple minor league levels and a strong competitive background to his next professional opportunity.

Chase Engelhard — Infielder


Hometown: Sandy Springs, GA

Chase Engelhard is an infielder from Riverwood High School in Sandy Springs, Georgia, where he was a four-year varsity baseball player and All-Region honoree. He played collegiately at Tulane University and Florida International University, posting a .311 average

with 32 hits and 13 RBI as a senior at FIU. Following college, Engelhard has continued his professional career with the Boise Hawks in the Pioneer League and has also competed internationally, representing Team Israel at the U-23 European Baseball Championship.

Kyle Henley, Outfielder

Kyle Henley is a professional baseball outfielder in the **Cincinnati Reds** organization. A native of **Alpharetta, Georgia**, and a standout at Denmark High School, Henley was selected by the Reds in the **14th round (408th overall) of the 2023 MLB Draft**, forgoing a commitment to play at Georgia Tech to begin his professional career. Known for his elite speed and athleticism, he has quickly become one of Cincinnati's exciting young prospects as he continues to develop in the minor leagues.

Colin Houck, Infielder

Colin Houck professional baseball infielder in the **New York Mets** organization. A native of **Lilburn, Georgia**, Houck starred at **Parkview High School**, where he was named the **Georgia Gatorade Baseball Player of the Year** after a standout senior season at the plate. He was selected by the Mets with the **32nd overall pick in the 2023 MLB Draft** and signed with the club in July of 2023, to begin his professional career. Houck made his pro debut in the Florida Complex League and has since played in the Mets' minor league system, including stints with the **St. Lucie Mets** and a promotion to the **Brooklyn Cyclones** as he continues his development as a top young prospect.
